At that time Brenda and her boyfriend, Mauricio, were high school students with typical teenage goals like hanging out with friends and getting good grades. With no independent housing options, jobs, or answers, they heard about Kindred Life when Program Director, Katie, came to speak at their school.

At the encouragement of their parents, they were married soon after Sebastian was born. Since joining the program, they have truly become a stronger family, sorting through the trials of teen parenting and finishing high school, together, with the help of Kindred Life. This young couple has not only been

completely committed to financial and emotional counseling, but have also grown in the knowledge of God as their Heavenly Father! They have become role models for other parents in their tightly knit community.

Mauricio works hard as a full time manager for a local restaurant and successfully graduated high school last spring. Brenda graduated

from Wheeling High School this spring where she was awarded student of the month in Sociology. She has since worked very hard to help provide for her family and begin her Licensed Professional Nursing program. With the help of our subsidized housing partner, Brenda, Mauricio and Sebastian now are able to live in their own apartment. 
